CATCO is Kids Presents Garfield: The Musical with Cattitude March 2-11

Musical features heartwarming story about beloved tabby cat

Garfield, the chubby and sarcastic tabby cat, wants to have the best birthday ever. But his friends, Arlene, Odie, Jon, and even his nemesis, Nermal, seem to have forgotten the special event. Meowch! Garfield runs away, but quickly learns an important life lesson – that "home is where the heart … and the food is."

Garfield's birthday adventure filled with songs and dance, performed by adult and children actors, will be performed at CATCO is Kids March 2-11, 2018, at the Columbus Performing Arts Center, Van Fleet Theatre, 549 Franklin Ave. Tickets are \$15 for adults; \$10 for kids.

"Who doesn't love Garfield? *The Musical with Cattitude* transports the beloved tabby cat of cartoon fame into a kid-sized musical full of entertainment and lessons about the importance of family and friends," said Joe Bishara, CATCO producing director. "Though created with kids of all ages in mind, *Garfield* presents a wonderful opportunity to introduce young children to theatre."

The role of Garfield will be played by Ben Hartwig, a former CATCO acting apprentice who performed in *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer*, *The Wolf Tales*, *A Christmas Carol* and *Forever Plaid*. He also has performed at Actors Theatre, Weathervane Playhouse and Evolution Theatre Company.

He is joined by Annie Huckaba (Arlene), and Candice Kight (Odie) and Nolan Thomaswick (Jon), current CATCO art education apprentices for the 2017-18 season. Huckaba, a former CATCO acting apprentice, recently appeared in CATCO is Kids production of *Knuffle Bunny: A Cautionary Musical*. Other recent credits include swing/vocal captain in *It's a Wonderful Life*, and *Dreamland Drive-In* both at Dollywood. Kight, who recently appeared in CATCO is Kids' production of *Daddy Long Legs* and *Madeline's Christmas*, has performed with theatre companies throughout Ohio. Thomaswick recently appeared in CATCO is Kids' production of *Knuffle Bunny: A Cautionary Musical* and *Madeline's Christmas*.

They are joined by Bailey Richmond (Nermal), a fifth grader at Royal Manor Elementary in Gahanna. Credits include performances at Star Performance Academy, State of the Art Productions and her school drama club.
