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Will Eno's The Realistic Joneses Presented at CATCO March 7-25

Contemporary dramatic comedy explores life's big questions through witty, insightful dialogue

Welcome to the Joneses' neighborhood – where suburbanites Bob and Jennifer and their new neighbors, John and Pony, discover they have even more in common than their identical homes and their shared last names. As their relationships begin to irrevocably intertwine, the Joneses ponder some of life's big questions and must decide between their idyllic fantasies and their imperfect realities.

"Designated the voice of his generation, playwright Will Eno's dramatic comedy, is packed with pithy dialogue that is packed with substance," said Joe Bishara, CATCO associate producing director and the director of *The Realistic Joneses*. "We are all bound to connect with the characters on some level as they maneuver through life just like the rest of us."

"Plays as funny and moving, as wonderful and weird as *The Realistic Joneses* ... do not appear often on Broadway. Or ever, really," says *The New York Times*. From *Time Out New York*: "Eno's dialogue is a marvel of compression and tonal control, trivial chitchat flipping into cosmic profundity with striking ease ... Life in Enoland isn't what you'd call realistic – it's more real than that."

CATCO will present *The Realistic Joneses* March 7-25, 2018, at the Vern Riffe Center, Studio One Theatre.

Performing in *The Realistic Joneses* are Ralph E. Scott (Bob Jones), and three newcomers to CATCO – Shenise Brown (Pony Jones), Bobby Loyd (John Jones) and Ella Palardi (Jennifer Jones). In addition to numerous regional and national commercial work, Scott is active in independent movies locally and throughout the Midwest. CATCO credits include *Ken Ludwig's Baskerville: A Sherlock Holmes' Mystery, The Three Trials Of Oscar Wilde, The Final Table, Next Fall, Bengal Tiger at the Baghdad Zoo, My Name Is Asher Lev, Evie's Waltz, The Foursome and The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee.*

Columbus native Brown studied theater at Columbia College in Chicago, and is the director of the theater department at A+ Arts Academy. She performs in local theaters. Loyd's acting credits include Footloose; Love, Sex, and the I.R.S.; I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change; Macbeth; Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat. Palardi is part of the morning team at Kool 101.7 FM. Her acting credits include Crimes of the Heart, Seminar, Twelve Angry Women, and The Innocents.

Bishara has worked at regional theatres in Ohio, Tennessee, Virginia, and Florida as an actor, director, producer, and administrator. At CATCO, he directed *Madeline's Christmas*, *Shakespeare and Star Wars: Verily, A New Hope; Anne of Green Gables, Sex With Strangers*,

James and the Giant Peach JR., The Kabuki Sleeping Beauty, Hansel and Gretel, Elephant and Piggie's "We are in a Play!," The Seussification of Romeo and Juliet, [title of show], Master Class, A Christmas Carol, I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change, and Forbidden Broadway's Greatest Hits: Vol. 1, and appeared in Daddy Long Legs, I Do! I Do! Dirty Rotten Scoundrels, Forbidden Broadway, The Story of My Life and Evil Dead: The Musical. Other acting credits include Titanic, Forbidden Broadway: SVU, The Rocky Horror Show and The Last Five Years. Additional directing credits include The Spitfire Grill, Bat Boy: The Musical, and If You Give a Mouse a Cookie, The House at Pooh Corner, Wind in the Willows, Encylopedia Brown, Peter and the Wolf, Beauty and the Beast (Isabella e la Bestia), and School House Rock Live!
