# CATCO is Kids Presents Regional Premiere of A Seussified Christmas Carol Dec. 2-11, 2016

### 21 central Ohio youths perform in this reinvention of holiday classic

Just in time for the holidays, CATCO is Kids will present a whimsical reinvention of Dickens' most beloved Christmas story, *A Christmas Carol*, in wacky rhymed couplets and creative word play. Featuring zoot-fruited juices and binka bird geese, and characters including Bed-Headed Fred and Timmy Loo Hoo, this tale of glorious holiday cheer is similar to something Dr. Seuss might have come up with if he ever had his way with the story.

"If you and your family enjoyed the CATCO 2015-16 season opener, *The Seussification of Romeo and Juliet*, you won't want to miss *A Seussified Christmas Carol*," said Joe Bishara, CATCO associate producing director.
