CATCO Presents Regional Premiere of Sex With Strangers Feb. 15-March 5

Edgy, smart comedy explores ambition, the literary world and sex in the digital age

Opposites attract in CATCO's upcoming regional premiere of *Sex With Strangers*, Feb. 15-March 5, when Olivia, a serious mid-career novelist meets Ethan, an author of dirty books (to call them erotica would press a point). Ultimately, she is as turned on by his commercial success as he is by her literary talent.

"How far will you go to get what you want?," said Joe Bishara, CATCO associate producing director and director of *Sex With Strangers*. "This smart, tantalizing take on modern love flirts with the ever-blurring line between public and private in our digital age."

Laura Eason's smart comedy will be performed at The Verne Riffe Center Studio Two Theatre, 77 S. High St.

Sex With Strangers premiered at Steppenwolf Theater Company in Chicago in 2011 and was performed in 2014 at Second Stage Theatre in New York City. "Wry, wise and wonderfully humorous ... a multi-faceted love story," says the Chicago Examiner, while other critics had this to say: "Sexually and intellectually provocative ...," The Hollywood Reporter, and "Just like a page-turner, this smart comedy pulls you in and keeps you wondering what's coming next," New York Daily News.

Playwright Eason is a screenwriter, playwright and director. In addition, she is a producer on the Emmy award-winning Netflix series *House of Cards*.

Performing in CATCO's production of *Sex With Strangers* is Nicolette Montana (Olivia) and Matthew Sierra (Ethan). Montana has performed, choreographed and directed performances with numerous local theatres, including CATCO, Available Light and Columbus Children's Theatre. At CATCO, she has appeared in *Evil Dead: The Musical, Avenue Q* and *The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*. Other acting credits include *A Piece of My Heart* (Leeann), *Hedwig and the Angry Inch* (Yitzhak), *Putting It Together* (Woman II), and *Cinderella* (Fairy Godmother).

Sierra, a 2016-17 CATCO acting apprentice, has appeared on stage at multiple central Ohio theatre organizations. His acting credits include Lord Alfred Douglas in CATCO's recent production of *Gross Indecency: The Three Trials of Oscar Wilde, Goldilocks and the Three Bears* and *The Kabuki Sleeping Beauty* with CATCO is Kids!, and *POZ* with Evolution Theatre company.

Bishara has worked at regional theatres in Ohio, Tennessee, Virginia, and Florida as an actor, director, producer, and administrator. At CATCO, he directed *James and the Giant Peach JR., The Kabuki Sleeping Beauty, Hansel and Gretel, Elephant and Piggie's "We are in a Play!," The Seussification of Romeo and Juliet, [title of show], Master Class, A Christmas Carol, I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change, Revenge of the Space Pandas, The Adventures of Tom*

Sawyer, The Rude Mechanicals, and Forbidden Broadway's Greatest Hits: Vol. 1, and appeared in Dirty Rotten Scoundrels, Forbidden Broadway, The Story of My Life and Evil Dead: The Musical. Other acting credits include Titanic, Forbidden Broadway: SVU, The Rocky Horror Show and The Last Five Years. Additional directing credits include The Spitfire Grill, Madeline's Christmas, Bat Boy: The Musical, and If You Give a Mouse a Cookie, The House at Pooh Corner, Wind in the Willows, Encylopedia Brown, Peter and the Wolf, Beauty and the Beast (Isabella e la Bestia), and School House Rock Live!

There are two previews for *Sex With Strangers*, Wednesday, Feb. 15, at 11 a.m., and Thursday, Feb. 16, at 7:30 p.m. Tickets are \$20 for the 11 a.m. performance, and \$30 for the 7:30 p.m. show. The opening performance is Friday, Feb. 17, at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$40.

For *Sex With Strangers*, there will be three 11 a.m. matinee performances: Wednesday, Feb. 15, Feb. 22 and March 1. Tickets are \$20.
