CATCO is Kids to Expand Programming to Dublin/Powell Fall 2019

Performances for fall musical, Disney's The Little Mermaid JR., set for Nov. 22-24

CATCO is Kids' announced today it will expand its programming to the Dublin/Powell area this fall with the production of *Disney's The Little Mermaid JR*. Nov. 22-24, 2019, following a successful expansion into New Albany last year.

"CATCO is Kids is excited about this new opportunity to take our youth programming to yet another part of central Ohio," said Joe Bishara, CATCO associate producing director. "For the past several years, we have seen an increase in the number of kids from Dublin and Powell participating in our classes and theatre programs. With those growing enrollment numbers have come requests from parents about expanding to those communities," he said.

The inaugural production will be *Disney's The Little Mermaid JR*., a journey under the sea with Ariel and friends, based upon the Academy Award-winning film and Broadway musical. The production will feature famous tunes from the musical – *Kiss the Girl, Under the Sea, Poor Unfortunate Souls* and *Part of Your World* – and is condensed for young actors to approximately one hour.

Disney's The Little Mermaid JR. will be a five-week theatre camp that results in a weekend of performances, similar to other CATCO is Kids' musical education programs. The camp will begin Oct. 13, 2019, with auditions taking place on the first day of the initiative. Online registration will begin Aug. 8, 2019, at catco.org. Rehearsals will be held Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Sundays from 5 p.m.-8 p.m.

All performances will be held at the Abbey Theatre in Dublin, 5600 Post Road, Dublin Community Recreation Center.

In 2018, the New Albany Arts Council tapped CATCO is Kids to provide administration and production of its musical program for young artists, Broadway, Jr. Musical, at the McCoy Center for the Arts. CATCO is Kids produced *Mary Poppins JR*. last July and *Willy Wonka JR*. earlier this month, both in association with the McCoy Center for the Arts.

Programs in New Albany and Dublin/Powell expand CATCO is Kids' long list of theatre programming for youth throughout central Ohio. In addition to CATCO is Kids' educational camps, other offerings include programming in local schools and the community, collaborations with other arts organizations, the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Learning Never Ends and the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department.

"As member of CATCO's board and resident of Dublin, I am thrilled about the expansion of CATCO is Kids into my community. Because of its longstanding reputation for creating and developing outstanding youth theatre programs throughout our community, the parents and youths in Dublin and Powell will be well-served," said Michael V. Wible, CATCO board member and a partner at Thompson Hine LLP.
