Children's classic features 28 central Ohio youths

CATCO is Kids will present a contemporary take on one of the world's most beloved children's tales with *Disney Alice in Wonderland JR*. Aug. 16-25, 2019.

Based on the 1951 Disney film, *Alice in Wonderland*, and the novels, *The Adventures of Alice in Wonderland* and *Through the Looking Glass* by Lewis Carroll, CATCO is Kids' production brings Carroll's famous heroine to life in a delightful adaptation featuring 28 central Ohio youths. Audiences will travel down the rabbit hole and join Alice, one of literature's most famous heroines, in her madcap adventures.
