CATCO Opens 2019-20 Season With Celebration of Frank Sinatra's Music

Cabaret-style performance of My Way, A Musical Tribute to Frank Sinatra performed Aug. 8-Sept. 1

CATCO will celebrate an American legend in its season opener, *My Way, A Musical Tribute to Frank Sinatra*. Featuring some of his most beloved songs – "Strangers in the Night," "New York, New York," "Fly Me to the Moon," "Love and Marriage," and "I've Got the World on a String," the tribute will be performed in the intimate Studio Three Theatre at the Riffe Center Aug. 8-Sept. 1.

"Frank Sinatra was the quintessential chameleon, and our tribute pays homage to the variety of moods and nuances that this deeply gifted self-inventor shared with his adoring fans throughout his career," said Steven C. Anderson, CATCO producing director and director of *My Way*. "It is our goal to transport audiences to a mid-20th Century night club to savor the music of one of the world's greatest performers."

"... Whether you're a Frank fan or just enjoy the Great American standards, treat yourself," says *Splash Magazine*, while *Chicago Theatre Beat* calls the show an "energetic, unique tribute to Ol' Blue Eyes."

Performing in My Way, conceived by David Grapes and Todd Olson with book by Todd Olson, is a veteran cast of central Ohio actors and vocalists:

- Shauna Marie Davis, who is returning to the CATCO stage after performing in last year's season opener, *Eubie!* Other acting credits include *Priscilla, Queen of the Dessert* at Evolution Theatre as a Diva.
- Joan Krause, who has performed in *The Club*, *Aspects of Love* and the one woman show, *Bad Dates*, at CATCO. Her 30-year acting career has included performing on stages in and out of the United States. Favorite roles include Lottie, (Parthy cover) in Hal Prince's revival of *Showboat* in Chicago and national tour; Miss Mona, *Best Little Whorehouse in Texas*; Eva Peron, *Evita*; Arlene, *Baby*; and Earth Mother, *Menopause the Musical*.
- Robert "Mac" McDannold, who is thrilled to be returning to CATCO after a long absence, having previously appeared in the company's production of *Tomfoolery*. His

long career on the Columbus stage has included musical roles at Players Theatre, Gallery Players, and Actor's Theatre of Columbus. He was last seen as Mr. Laurence in Actor's Theatre's recent production of *Little Women*.

• Patrick Schaefer, who is a graduate of Otterbein University's musical theatre program and has performed in New York City and Ohio. Recent credits include *Peter Pan* (Starkey) and *Tuck Everlasting* (Angus) with Columbus Children's Theatre; *Mamma Mia* (Bill) and *La Cage Aux Folles* (Francis) with Short North Stage; and *My Fair Lady* (Freddy), *Heathers* (Ensemble) and *The Wild Party* (Burrs) with Imagine Productions.

Also appearing on the stage is Quinton Jones, *My Way* music director and costume designer. Jones, who has served as music director for many CATCO shows, also is a costume designer, specializing in fashions unique to drag queens. He recently designed the costumes for CATCO's productions of *Life Sucks*. and *Holmes and Watson*.

Anderson's directing credits include plays as diverse as the central Ohio premiere and first non-touring production in Ohio of Fun Home, as well as Holmes and Watson, Life Sucks., Every Brilliant Thing, Eubie!, world premieres of Henry Ford's Model E and The Final Table, Gross Indecency: The Three Trials of Oscar Wilde, Peter and the Starcatcher, Avenue Q, and the highly acclaimed production of Doug Wright's I Am My Own Wife. He has also directed Candide and Hair at The Ohio State University Theatre Department; Love! Velour! Compassion! and The Taste of Sunrise at CATCO; Big River and Pippin at Actors Theatre; A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum at New Harmony Theatre; and Greater Tuna, Little Shop of Horrors, and Assassins at the former Players Theatre Columbus where he served as Associate Producing Director.
