#### CATCO is Kids Presents Ohio Premiere of *Press Start!* March 6-15

## Nintendo and Sega video games come to life with cast of 21 central Ohio youths

Be transported to the bright, pixelated world of classic Nintendo and Sega video games in *Press Start! A New 8-Bit Musical*, an Ohio premiere presented at CATCO is Kids March 6-15, featuring a cast of 21 central Ohio youths.

When the famous characters in the play run out of lives, they decide to put on a musical fund-raiser that will help them raise gold rings and play on through hilarious and heartfelt musical numbers composed in 8-bit synthesizers, such as *The Villain Song, The Hero Song* and *The Sidekick Song*. When things go terribly awry, the quiet sidekick Little Mushroom must find the hero within to help save the day.

"In this new, interactive musical, audience members help their video game favorites gain more lives and 'play on,' while learning important lessons about friendship, working together and that heroes are not the only ones who can be heroes," said Andrew Protopapas, CATCO interim education director and the director of *Press Start!* "This show, which appeals to adults, as well as kids, is part nostalgia, part humorous journey into the world of video games," he said.

*Press Start!* contains references to and similar characters from the following video game franchises: The Legend of Zelda, Sonic the Hedgehog, Mario, Pac Man, Megaman, Minecraft and Angry Birds. All performances will be in the VanFleet Theatre, Columbus Performing Arts Center, 549 Franklin Ave. Tickets are \$15 for adults, \$10 for kids.
