CATCO is Kids, Columbus Children's Theatre Announce Matilda Cancellation

Central Ohio's premiere youth theatre companies were to co-produce musical May 7-24

CATCO is Kids and Columbus Children's Theatre, the region's premiere youth theatre organizations, announced today plans to cancel their co-production of *Roald Dahl's Matilda The Musical*, winner of multiple Tony and Olivier awards, scheduled for May 7-24, 2020.

"It is with deep sadness that we have decided to cancel *Matilda*," Steven C. Anderson, CATCO's producing director, and Susan Pringle, executive director of Columbus Children's Theatre, said. "Our priority since Gov. DeWine's directive to limit public gatherings earlier this month has been the safety of our patrons and performers. We felt the large cast size and magnitude of such a large-scale musical would simply put too many of our central Ohio youth performers at risk, thus requiring this drastic action."

"This collaboration was to be a first for our two groups, and we hope that we can partner again at a future date, just as we hope to connect again with our patrons as soon as possible," Anderson and Pringle said. "In the meantime, please stay in touch with us at our respective websites – catco.org and columbuschildrenstheatre.org – for updates and announcements about our exciting 2020-21 seasons."

Since the cancellation will affect the financial well-being of the theatre organizations, they are asking subscribers and those who have purchased tickets to consider donating their tickets back to CATCO is Kids and Columbus Children's Theatre instead of asking for refunds. Matilda The Musical, inspired by the genius of Roald Dahl, is the captivating masterpiece from the Royal Shakespeare Company that revels in the anarchy of childhood, the power of imagination and the story of a young girl who dreams of a better life. The tale of Matilda, a special child with an extraordinary imagination, has delighted audiences young and old since its premiere on London's West End in 2011 and

on Broadway in 2013.
