

Lesson 7 Ending Activity:

Look at your activities from the past two videos. You have a list of all events in your favorite book divided up into Beginning, Middle, and End. You have a second list of all events divided up into Exposition, Rising Action, Climax, Falling Action, and Resolution.

Use one of these lists to come up with an outline of what a play about your favorite book would be like.

If you choose to use your three-part list, plan a play with three scenes: Scene 1—Beginning, Scene 2—Middle, and Scene 3—End.

If you choose to use your five-part list, plan a play with five scenes: Scene 1—Exposition, Scene 2—Rising Action, Scene 3—Climax, Scene 4—Falling Action, and Scene 5—Resolution.

You may have to take things out of the story so that your play is not super long. Think about what is most important to tell the story in your favorite book.

Use another piece of paper or a computer to answer these questions.
